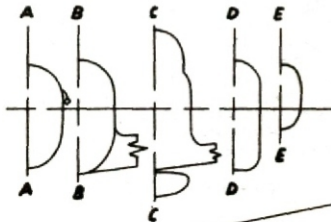


**NORTH AMERICAN P-51
"MUSTANG" (1944)**

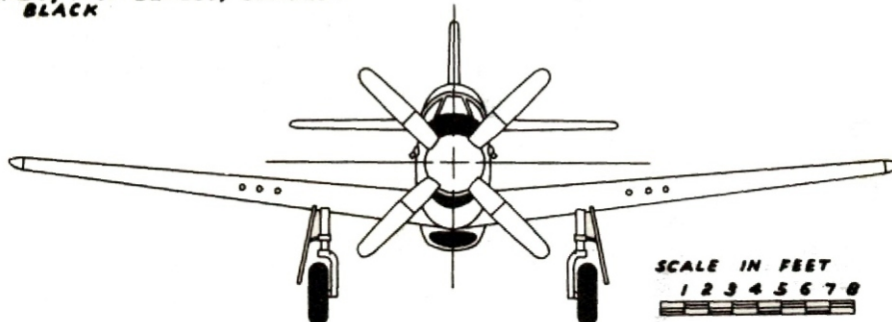
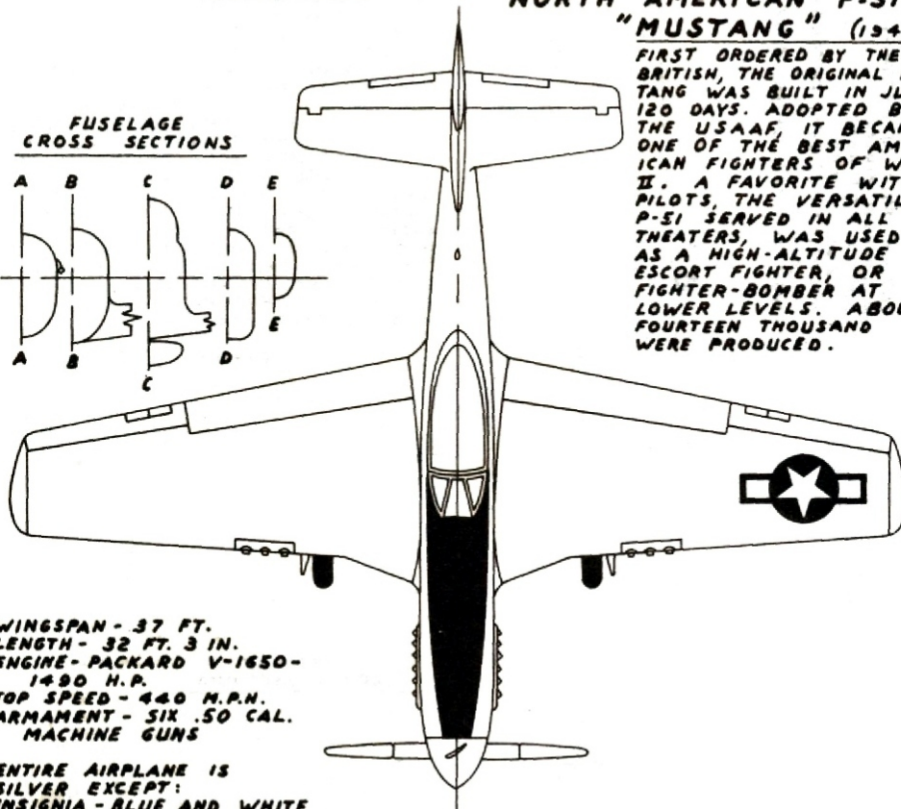
FIRST ORDERED BY THE BRITISH, THE ORIGINAL MUSTANG WAS BUILT IN JUST 120 DAYS. ADOPTED BY THE USAAF, IT BECAME ONE OF THE BEST AMERICAN FIGHTERS OF W.W. II. A FAVORITE WITH PILOTS, THE VERSATILE P-51 SERVED IN ALL THEATERS, WAS USED AS A HIGH-ALTITUDE ESCORT FIGHTER, OR FIGHTER-BOMBER AT LOWER LEVELS. ABOUT FOURTEEN THOUSAND WERE PRODUCED.
